Barbara L. Taylor, “Barb”, 57, of Hampshire passed away suddenly Thursday, Sept. 20, 2018.

She was born May 3, 1961 in Belvidere the daughter of Fred and Joanne (Pfaffinger) Bishop. She was a 1979 graduate of Hampshire High School and received her teaching degree from NIU. Barb married James E. Taylor on August 8, 1981 in Hampshire.

Her teaching career spanned 35 years, the past 21 years with District 300. She was a Phys. Ed. teacher at St. Charles Borromeo School and Director of the Hampshire Park District before teaching full time. She previously worked at Eastview Elementary and Golfview Elementary as a Phys. Ed. teacher. The past 11 years she was with the Hampshire Middle School as a Phys. Ed. Teacher and girls’ volleyball coach and 7th-grade girls’ basketball coach.
