Clarence J. Gburek, 84, of Marengo, passed away suddenly Tuesday evening, March 19, 2024, at Northwestern Hospital in Woodstock.

He was born February 25, 1940, in Dewey, WI the son of Joseph and Sophie (Pawlik) Gburek. He married Audrey Ryba on October 6, 1962, in Chicago. He worked at United Airlines as a supervisor for many years. Clarence was a very active member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church as a member with the Knight of Columbus Council #13476 and was a Grand Knight 4th Degree Navigator, Dist. Deputy for 4 years, the Knights of the Round table, and was essential in starting the programs for the blood drive, selling hanging baskets for tuition for catholic schools, and pumpkin sales for Right to Life. Clarence was an avid Green Bay Packer fan and loved spending time with his family. He will be deeply missed.

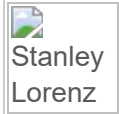
