Edward E. "Eddie" Hennig, 86, of Hampshire, passed away Monday morning, November 6, 2023, at home surrounded by his family.

He was born August 28, 1937, in Hampshire, the son of William and Esther (Sanwald) Hennig, Sr. He was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean War. He married Donna M. Cox on October 26, 1963, in Hampshire. He was self-employed as a retail salesman in the dairy and corn supply business, and the custom feed grind business. Eddie was a lifelong resident of Hampshire, and a member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church. He was an avid fisherman & hunter and will be deeply missed.
