James “Mike” Hartman, 66, of Hampshire passed away suddenly in his home on Wednesday, Aug. 28, 2019.

Mike was born on April 5, 1953, in Elgin the son of Leonard and Jean (Helfvogt) Hartman. Mike married Janet L. Geltner on October 27, 1973, in Elgin. They moved to the country in 1979 and built their family home in Hampshire, IL.

Mike worked for the municipality of Elgin for 37 ½ years as a chief operator of the Fox River Water Reclamation District. 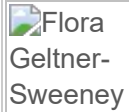
