John E. Miller "Jack" went to the Lord on November 13, 2019, in Hampshire Illinois.

He was born in Corning, Iowa on June 15, 1930. Jack grew up in Iowa before moving to Elgin, Illinois, then moved to Hampshire, Illinois in 1956. Jack, the Hitzeroth brothers, and Harry Haderer built the Miller's home in 1963.

Jack is preceded in death by his parents, George E. and Marguerite (Ford) Miller; Siblings, Bob Miller, Marjorie Stonecipher, and Betty Purnell.
