Patricia H. Meyers, 83, of Marengo, a retired teacher, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, June 10, 2022.

Born in Chicago on January 1, 1939, Patricia was the daughter of the late Harry and Bernice (nee Litwin) Novak. She was a graduate of Lindbloom High School in Chicago, and Northern Illinois University.

Patricia married the love of her life, Harvey A. Meyers, on January 20, 1962, in Chicago.

Patricia's early teaching career began at Loop College (n/k/a Harold Washington College) in 1963 in Chicago, where she taught business skills as part of a new government initiative at the time. She purchased the first equipment and supplies for her empty classroom while awaiting delivery of needed items. As a new teacher, she was the youngest person in her own classroom.

After relocating to the Marengo area, Patricia was contacted by local schools in need of teachers. She began teaching elementary school in 1965, first in Belvidere, and then in 1966 in Marengo. Throughout her teaching career, Patricia primarily taught second and fourth grades. She felt blessed that she deeply enjoyed her profession. Patricia truly loved teaching, her students, and

her coworkers, and it showed. Throughout her career, she touched many lives.

To say Patricia was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother would be an understatement. She showed her deep love for her family through her attentive care. Her family enjoyed numerous home cooked meals, and she was designated best cook in the family by her grandchildren.

In addition to her family, Patricia had various passions including golfing, reading, traveling, birdwatching, and word games. She was a longstanding member of the Marengo community. She cherished her neighborhood of over forty years. She was excellent company. Most importantly, Patricia was thoughtful, gentle, pleasant, loving and kind.

Patricia is survived by her two children, Mark (Anja) Meyers and Kimberly (Gary) Johnson; three grandchildren, Elizabeth, Jack and Gavin; her sister-in-law, Ann Novak; several cousins; and special neighbors and friends.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Harvey, and her brother, Robert.
