Patricia Ann Miller, 84, of Geneva, formerly of Burlington/Hampshire, passed away Thursday, May 15, 2025.

She was born on November 30, 1940, in Elgin, the daughter of Frank and Dorothy (Peters) Zirk. She was a 1958 member of the Class of Elgin High School and then received her RN nursing degree in 1961 from Illinois Masonic Hospital in Chicago. On September 23, 1961, she married Donald Miller at St. Laurence Catholic Church in Elgin. She worked as an RN for Sherman Hospital and House Nursing Home (formerly Simpson) in Elgin and was a participant in the establishing of Home Nursing Care for over 8 years. Pat was a volunteer RN/EMT for the Burlington Fire Protection District for 4 years. Pat was a very active member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church, a member of the choir for over 30 years, a former member of Pastoral Council (several years), served as Liturgy Chairman, and member and officer of Altar and Rosary. She also belonged to Homemakers Education Assoc. for over 35 years and served as an officer and belonged to the Book Club for over 15 years.

She is survived by her four children, Lynn C. (Matt) Kindy, Donald F. Jr. (Kim) Miller, Dorothy E. Meyer, and Robert T. (Regina) Miller; eight grandchildren, Melissa, Matthew (Daniella), Mark (Lauren) Donald F. III, Nathaniel, Nicole, Kyle, Tessa (Dave), Kevin (Lindsay); and three great grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Don in 1998; and sister, Delores Coleman.
