



## Walter J. Leucht

October 12, 1953 - August 14, 2023

Walter J. Leucht, 69, of Hampshire, passed away early Monday morning, August 14, 2023, at his home in Hampshire.

He was born October 12, 1953, in Woodstock, the son of Charles and Jacquelyn (Conger) Leucht. He was a member of the 1971 Class of Marian Central Catholic High School and received his bachelor's degree in political science from Murray State College University in 1975. He graduated from the Worsham College of Mortuary Science in 1976. Walter married Judith L. Harper on Nov. 6, 1976, in Eminence, KY and they were partners in the operation of Fredrick Funeral Home in Hampshire which they purchased in 1980. In 1986 he purchased the James A. O'Connor Funeral Home in Huntley and was very proud to serve the families in Hampshire, Huntley, Burlington, and Plato areas. He was very dedicated to his profession.

Walter was an accomplished golfer and was a member of Woodstock Country Club for over 38 years. He was a 12-time club champion, 10-time senior champion, and 3-time McHenry Co. Senior Champion. He also was a top 10 and top 20 finisher in the Illinois State Senior Amateur and had 7 holes-in-one to his credit. He made many great friends playing golf and many would join him in South Texas for the annual golf trip.

Surviving is his wife and partner Judy; sons, Joseph (Jenni) Leucht of Marengo, Matthew Leucht of Hampshire; two granddaughters he adored,

twins, Emma, and Cadence; siblings, Chuck (Patti) Leucht, Regina (Wiley) Bell, John F. (Cathy) Leucht; many nieces, nephews, and great friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Charles and Jacquelyn; his baby brother, Kevin Christopher (KC); and his beloved sister, Teresa Pappas.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 AM on Saturday, August 19th at St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church, 297 Jefferson Ave. in Hampshire. Burial will follow in the Hampshire Center Cemetery.
